LINCOLN SWCD MONITORING PLAN FOR BUFFER COMPLIANCE TRACKING

§103F.48 RIPARIAN PROTECTION AND WATER QUALITY PRACTICES

1. COMPLIANCE TRACKING OF ALL PARCELS SUBJECT TO THE BUFFER LAW

All parcels in Lincoln County are to be reviewed within a 3-year timeframe. The Lincoln SWCD will review 1/3 of the parcels each year.

Compliance monitoring will be done using aerial photo review or on-site drive-by review depending on availability of updated aerial photos and access. A combination of both aerial and on-site review may also be used.

2. RANDOM SPOT CHECKS

Random spot checks will be conducted in addition to tracking all parcels within a 3-year period. These checks may be conducted via aerial photo review or on-site drive-by review, depending on availability of updated aerial photos, visibility from the road, and access to property. A combination of both aerial and on-site drive-by reviews may also be used.

3. PROCESS TO HANDLE COMPLAINTS

The Lincoln SWCD will investigate public complaints related to buffer law compliance. Complaints will be checked via aerial photo review or on-site drive-by review depending on availability of updated aerial photos and access to property. A combination of both aerial and on-site drive-by review may also be used.
